

1. Grievance related to examinations


- Controller of the Examinations reported that 15 complaints from UG students and nil complaints from PG students were submitted against the evaluation in the examinations held in May-June this year.

2. Examination matters


- Controller of the Examinations reported that 10 complaints from UG students and nil complaints from PG students were submitted against the evaluation in the examinations held in May-June this year.


Principal reported that we are trying to use battery powered vehicle within the campus.



2. Examination related matters :


- Controller of the Examinations reported that 4 complaints from UG students and 4 complaints from PG students were submitted against the evaluation in the examinations held in May-June this year.
