Sub : Corrigendum Notice

This is a corrigendum to the UG 6th Sem Examination Schedule notice that was circulated on 2 July, 2021. The dates of the examinations of the UG 6th Sem Statistics have changed to the following dates based on the request from the students.

Theory Examination:

Note:

- Practical Examinations will be completed by 30 July, 2021. The exact dates of practical Examination, Midsemester / Internal Continuous examinations and Tutorial Examinations will be fixed by the respective Departments.

Kindly note the following important points related to the online examination:

1. The Departments will send the question paper and collect the answer scripts from the students, as it was done in the previous semester.
2. An extra **15 minutes** will be given at the beginning and another **30 minutes** after the completion of the exam, for online distribution of question papers and submission of answer scripts, respectively.
3. In the previous semester it was noted that a small percentage of students had submitted their scanned copies which were relatively dark. Such students are advised to check/change their apps or settings of their phones/scanners and send a clean scanned copy as far as possible. They can ask their friends for help/suggestion.

4. If a student is unable to submit the answer scripts at any point of time (within 30 minutes after the exam) due to technical issues, he should inform the concerned teacher immediately . He should also provide a screenshot/photo of the problem he is facing as an evidence to the email/Whatsapp number of the teacher in-charge. If the college finds out that the case is not genuine, then a disciplinary committee will take a decision on the outcome of his exam. If a student has not submitted the answer script even after 30 minutes after the exam, he is asked to contact the Principal Maharaj.
5. Students are requested to maintain the sanctity and integrity of the exam. Thus, sharing answers or copying them from other examinees is strictly prohibited. While reviewing the answers, if a teacher senses an unfair means has been employed, he can ring the student and question his understanding on what he has written, within 20 days from the day of the exam.
