### ADMISSION TO M.A./M.Sc. COURSE: 2021 - 22 (ONLY FOR BOYS)

- 1. Students who have passed or have appeared / passed in the B.A. / B.Sc. 3<sup>rd</sup> yr or 6<sup>th</sup> semester in 2021 can apply.
- 2. Students who have passed the B.A. / B.Sc. 3<sup>rd</sup> yr or 6<sup>th</sup> semester examination in 2020 can also apply.
- Admission of students will be done fully on the merit basis. Towards this, the college has designed different specific methods for specific subjects. However, the entire process will be online.
- 4. While filling up online admission form Students must write their Gmail id and phone number with utmost care. [In case someone does not have a Gmail id, he has to create one for this purpose and give only that Gmail id.] These will be required at different stages of the admission process. Therefore, an applicant should regularly check his email id during the admission process.

The college will not take any responsibility if any document or intimation sent by the college to these registered e-mail ids given by the student bounces back.

Further, incomplete application form will lead to the cancellation of the candidature.

- 5. For all types of notifications, publication of short-listed students name for online assessment (written and/or viva voce), publication of provisional merit list, publication of waiting list(s), dates of admission and allied matters, the website (www.rkmrc.in) should be followed meticulously. Institution will not accept any failure in this regard from the side of an applicant. No individual email reminders will be sent for the written online test. The time & date of the examinations are mentioned below in Section 13. Concerned candidates should be ready waiting for the question paper at the stipulated time. See Section 12 for details subject wise.

#### 10. Issue & Submission of Application Forms (Online only):

- a. Date: 13 September 2021 (11.00 a.m.) to 26 September 2021 (5.00 p.m.)
- b. Students should keep with them Admit Cards as generated from the Portal. This may be required at different stages of the admission process and even during the actual time of arrival at the hostel.
- c. The students will be required to upload
  - 1. recent passport size photograph & Signature (JPG format, < 100 kb).
- d. After the final selection, admission fees will be received online after completing some other procedural requirement which may include counseling over video or audio call. However, regarding all these, there will be a separate notification when the Provisional List of the Selected Candidates will be notified.
- e. Important Points to note:
  - 1. The college is fully residential one and all students will be required to stay on campus-hostels mandatorily. No day-scholar system will be allowed at any point of time. However, given the situation cropped up due to the recent pandemic, the hostel will remain closed even after admission till further notice.
  - 2. Students will be intimated regarding their arrival at the hostel and allied matters in due course.
  - 3. Students are further requested to look into the website for different notifications. Students should not expect any personal email intimation from the college authority.
  - 4. Students should carefully read the rules and regulations that are available on the college web portal.
  - 5. Students who are unable to pay the online application fees due to their economically weak background are requested to mail to <a href="mailto:admission@rkmrc.in">admission@rkmrc.in</a> with relevant documents as attachment.
  - 6. Scholarships are granted to financially weak students.

#### 12. Selection Procedure is mentioned below:

#### A. English:

- a) There will be an online Home Assignment Test of 2 hours duration carrying 50 marks. Candidates will be required to attempt two questions, each carrying 25 marks.
- b) While filling up the online application form, candidates must provide their email id and phone number (preferably a WhatsApp number).
- c) The college will send the Home Assignment to the email id provided by the candidates.
- d) Candidates should mention their name, application number and phone number at the top of the blank paper where they will write out the Assignment answers.
- e) The answers must be written in the candidates' own hand writing (preferably in black ink) which may be verified at any later stage after the pandemic situation gets over.
- f) The candidates should also mention on their answer script the precise time when they have received the Home Assignment mail and the precise time they have completed their writing. This span shall be limited to 2 hours with a maximum buffer time of 15 minutes.
- g) The Home Assignment Test will be held on 29 September 2021 from 11.30 am to 1.30 pm. The college will try to send the topic/question through email by 11.25 am on 18 November.
- h) The actual time count of 2 hours with a maximum buffer time of 15 minutes, under all possible circumstances, will start from 11.30 am.
- i) If a candidate does not receive the Home Assignment by 11.45 am, he must report to <a href="mailto:english@rkmrc.in">english@rkmrc.in</a> by sending a mail within 5 minutes, i.e., by 11.50 am. For such a type of delay candidates will not be discredited.
- j) However, after 11.50 am no request of time-accommodation will be entertained and the candidate will be marked absent.
- k) After writing the answer scripts, candidates shall upload the scanned copy of the answer script in one single legible .pdf format through a Google form within 2 hours with a maximum buffer time of 15 minutes. The uploading details will be mentioned in the email through which the Home Assignment is sent.
- I) If a candidate fails to send the copy within this time limit, he will be marked absent in the Test.
- m) Any technical issue related to sending the answer script should be informed within this time limit.
- n) After the Home Assignment Test there will be a short-listing of the candidates.
- o) This short-listing will be done based on

#### **B.** Physics:

- a. There will be an online test of 30 minute duration carrying 20 marks.
- b. Syllabus for the above-mentioned online test: PHYSICS Honours Standard: That of various all India level competitive examinations.
- c. Question Pattern of the online test: Subjective and numerical (both concept based and numerical problems).
- d. While filling up the online application form, candidates must provide their e-mail id and phone number (preferably a WhatsApp number).
- e. The college will send the online test question paper to the e-mail id provided by the candidates.
- f. Candidates should mention their name, application number and phone number (which they have written during the filling up of application form) at the top of the blank paper where they will write out the answers.
- g. The answers must be written in the candidates' own hand writing (preferably in black ink) which may be verified at any later stage after the pandemic situation gets over.
- h. The candidates should also mention on their answer script the precise time when they have received the e-mail and the precise time at which they have completed writing their answer. This entire span shall be limited to 30 minutes with a maximum buffer time of 15 minutes.
- i. The question paper for the Online Test will be sent to the students through e-mail 5 minutes before the scheduled time for the commencement of the examination.
- j. If a candidate does not receive the question paper 5 minutes before the scheduled time for the commencement of the examination, he must report to <a href="mailto:physics@rkmrc.in">physics@rkmrc.in</a> by sending an e-mail. For such type of delay candidates will not be discredited.
- k. After writing the answers in the answer scripts, candidates shall send the scanned copy of the answer script as one single legible file in .pdf format through a Google form. The whole process of writing the examination, scanning the answer script and uploading it has to be completed within 30 minutes, with a maximum buffer time of 15 minutes. The details of uploading of the answer scripts will be mentioned in the email through which the question paper is sent.
- I. If a candidate fails to send the copy within this time limit, he will be marked absent in the Test.

- m. Any technical issue related to sending the answer script should be informed within this time limit.
- iii. After the online test there will be a short-listing of the candidates eligible for the next level of the admission process. This short-listing will be done based on

- 4. Final Selection will be done based on

- 5. If there arises a tie among the final short-listed candidates, the tie-breaking will be done based on the following serial:
  - 1. 1st Key: Marks obtained in Viva Voce
  - 2. 2nd key: Marks obtained in B.Sc. Computer Science Honours
- 6. After the 2nd key if the tie remains, the college authorities will decide upon the method of breaking the tie.

#### D. Chemistry:

- 1. There will be a short-listing of the candidates for an online Viva Voce.
- 2. This short-listing will be done based on

Marks obtained in B.Sc. Chemistry Honours (converted to 100)

- 3. The short-listed candidates will be required to attend a Viva Voce through video call/audio call/WhatsApp call to be organized by the college. (Viva Voce Marks: 10)
- 4. Final Selection will be done based on

Marks obtained in B.Sc. Chemistry Honours (converted to 100)

Marks obtained in Viva Voce Multiplied by 10 (out of 100)

- 5. If there arises a tie among the final short-listed candidates, the tie-breaking will be done based on the following serial:
  - 1. 1st Key: Marks obtained in Viva Voce
  - 2. 2nd key: Marks obtained in B.Sc. Computer Science Honours
- 6. After the 2nd key if the tie remains, the college authorities will decide upon the method of breaking the tie.
