1. **A Candidate can apply for as many subjects as he chooses. Students who passed H.S./ equivalent Examinations before 2021 cannot apply.**

Students from CBSE, ISE and other boards who have not yet received their Class 12 marks should enter their Class 11 Final marks in the application while filling the mark details under **Details of 10 + 2** Section. **If such a student gets provisionally selected for admission after the test, he should also meet the eligibility criteria mentioned below based on his class 12 results by providing the Class 12 mark sheet at the time of his admission, otherwise his admission stands cancelled.**

**Note: (a)** Aggregate marks shall be computed by adding the marks of the top-five subjects (in case of West Bengal Council) and the top-four subjects (in case of other boards including CBSE and ISC) in order of the marks secured by a candidate. Marks in compulsory Environmental Education/Studies shall not be taken into account for calculation of aggregate marks. However, if the subject “Environmental Science” is studied as an elective subject of 100 marks, it may be taken into account for the purpose of determining the aggregate marks.

**(b)** 5% relaxation in aggregate & subject (where applicable) for SC/ST candidates.

#### 4. Issue & Submission of Application Forms (Online only) :

a) **Date : 11 June 2022 (10.00 a.m.) to 3 July 2022 (2.00 p.m.)**

**Note: All the formalities including online payment to be completed within this period.**

b) Applicant should carefully keep with him the Admit Card generated through the college admission web portal. This may be required at different stages of the admission process and even during the actual time of arrival at the hostel

a) Recent passport size photograph & Signature (JPG format, file size < 100 kb).

c) No Candidate will be allowed to take the admission test **without production of the Admit Card.**

#### 5. Reservation Policy:

Reservation Policy for admission in three year (six semesters) degree courses of studies shall be guided by the West Bengal State Higher Educational Institutions (Reservation in Admission), Act, 2013 and the West Bengal State Higher Educational Institutions (Reservation in Admission) Rules, 2014.

Note: Since some subjects are to be held simultaneously, applicants opting for these subjects are required to meet the Principal half an hour before the commencement of their examinations. A separate schedule will be arranged for their second option.

#### 7. General / Generic subject combinations for Honours Programme:

**Note : Before choosing your generic subject / course, students are requested to carefully read the following conditions. :**

There are 6 Honours Programmes in Science Group (Chemistry, Computer Science, Economics, Mathematics, Physics, Statistics) and 6 in Arts / Humanities Group (English, Sanskrit, History, Political Science, Philosophy, Bengali)

- i. A student who wishes to study Honours programme from the Arts / Humanities group as mentioned above will have to take any two other generic/general subjects, at least one of which must be from Arts / Humanities Group.
- ii. A student who wishes to study Honours programme from the Science Group as mentioned above will have to take any two other generic/general subjects, at least one of which must be from Science Group.

- iii. The TABLE A below gives the two pools from which a student will choose one generic elective from each pool. No student should take the same subject from both the pools. Students are also not allowed to take two subjects from one pool.
- iv. The following four combinations given below cannot be taken together either as Honours / General (Generic) combinations or as two General (Generic) combinations.
- a) History, Mathematics b) Chemistry, Sanskrit c) Political Science, Electronics  
d) Computer Science, Bengali
- v. Special conditions for admission to the Honours courses:
- a) Candidates who have passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) vocational Examinations conducted by West Bengal State Council of Vocational Education and Training **cannot** apply.
- b) A candidate shall not be allowed to take up Honours in the programmes under heading A if he has not passed the subject(s) mentioned under the heading B in the HS / equivalent examination.

Duration of test: 2 hours


**B) Use of Calculator:**

**11. List for provisional selection will be prepared on the basis of the marks obtained in the Admission Test of their respective departments only.**

If there is a tie among the final short-listed candidates, the tie-breaking will be done based on the following order:

- a) **1st Key:** Percentage of the Aggregate Marks obtained in class 12 (in case of WBHSE) and in class 11 (in case of other boards where class 12 marks have not been announced such as CBSE, ISE etc.) Aggregate percentage will be computed as explained in Note (a) under point no. 3 mentioned above.
  - b) **2nd Key:** A suitable criterion will be decided by the college authority based on the department in question. The criterion will be announced at the time of announcement of result if the use of second tie-breaking situation arises.
12. Please note that the college is a fully residential one. All students should reside compulsorily on campus. Day-scholars are not allowed.
13. Scholarships are granted to a restricted number of **meritorious but financially weak students.**

**Please note that if any candidate fails to fulfill the eligibility criteria as mentioned in our admission notice his candidature will automatically stand cancelled as soon as it is detected at any stage of the admission process.**
